YELLOW FEVER

200,000 CASES AND 30,000 DEATHS WORLDWIDE EACH YEAR
UP TO 50% OF SEVERELY AFFECTED WILL DIE WITHOUT TREATMENT

CHIKUNGUNYA

CAUSES FEVER AND DEBILITATING JOINT PAIN
NO CURE FOR THE DISEASE
